Polypropylene	- Clean with a diluted 10:1 water to bleach solution.
Frame Finishes	<ul> <li>Powder Coats: Clean with a slightly damp cloth using a mild solution of soap and water. Bleach cleanable with 10:1 ratio of water to bleach.</li> <li>Chrome: Clean with a high quality chrome cleaner to ensure the brightest finish. Bleach cleanable with 10:1 ratio of water to bleach.</li> <li>Aluminum &amp; Stainless Steel: Clean with a damp soft cloth using a mild soap solution or glass cleaner. No abrasive cleaners should be used. Bleach cleanable with 10:1 ratio of water to bleach.</li> </ul>

PET Felt	<ul> <li>Most stains can be cleaned with water. Apply water on the stain and blot with a clean towel. Reapply water as needed.</li> <li>For tough stains, use a mild cleaner or detergent. A diluted 10:1 water to bleach solution may also be used.</li> </ul>
Solid Wood	<ul> <li>Wood top coat is resistant to most household chemicals (ex. 409, Fantastic, Murphy's or Pledge). We recommend trying a small or hidden spot first with any cleaner before using on entire surface.</li> <li>Avoid hot products on surface.</li> <li>Clean spills with mild soap and water using a damp cloth. Apply solution with spray bottle, wipe clean, and dry with soft cloth.</li> <li>Avoid harsh or abrasive cleaning materials.</li> <li>Do not use furniture polish containing oil, wax, or silicone which can produce an oily film or haze.</li> </ul>
Outdoor Furniture	<ul> <li>Cleaning and maintenance of outdoor furniture is key to its durability. Use this method for a quick clean up throughout the season. Use a mild bleach solution for stubborn stains.</li> <li>1. Mix mild dish soap with warm water.</li> <li>2. Use a clean cloth to wipe soapy mixture onto surfaces, cleaning off excess dirt.</li> <li>3. To sanitize, mix 1/3 bleach and 2/3 water and then apply bleach cleaning solution with clean cloth.</li> <li>4. Rinse thoroughly.</li> </ul>
